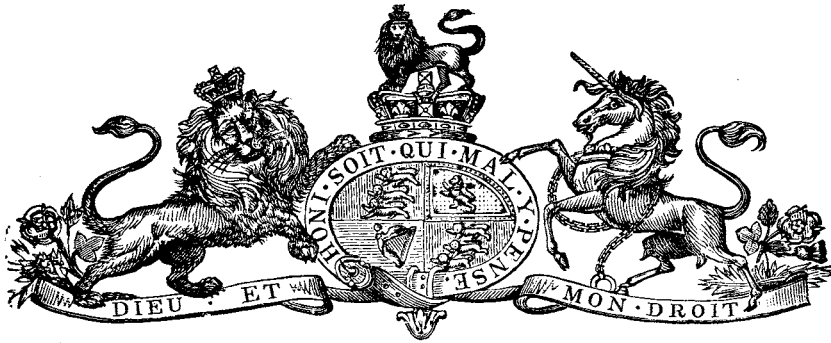

AN ACT to amend "The *Zeehan* Railway A.D. 1889.  
Construction Act, 1889."  
[9 *November*, 1889.]

**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1** In this Act the expression "the said Act" means "The *Zeehan* Railway Construction Act, 1889." Interpretation.

**2** It shall be lawful for the Minister to cause to be expended upon the construction and completion of the Line of Railway to be called "The *Zeehan* Railway," a sum not exceeding Seventy thousand Pounds, such sum to be in addition to the sum of Sixty thousand Pounds authorised to be expended by the said Act. Additional  
expenditure for  
construction of  
Railway.

**3** The whole of the moneys authorised to be expended by this Act shall be defrayed out of the moneys to be provided by Parliament for that purpose. Defrayment of  
cost of Works.

**4** This Act and the said Act, save as amended by this Act, shall be read and construed together as one Act. Acts to be read  
together.
