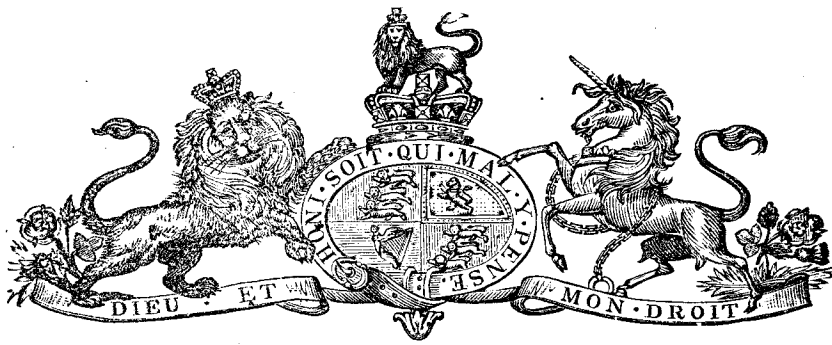

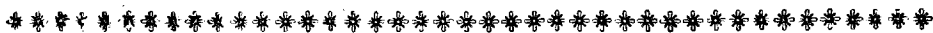

AN ACT to continue “An Act to authorise the Minister of Lands and Works to vary a certain Agreement entered into on the Twenty-second day of *December*, One thousand eight hundred and ninety-two, with ‘The *Mount Dundas* and *Zeehan* Railway Company, Limited.’”

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 In this Act the expression “the said Act” shall mean “An Act to authorise the Minister of Lands and Works to vary an Agreement entered into on the Twenty-second day of *December*, One thousand eight hundred and ninety-two, with ‘The *Mount Dundas* and *Zeehan* Railway Company, Limited.’”

Interpretation.

2 It shall be lawful for the Minister of Lands and Works for the time being to exercise all the powers conferred upon him by the said Act for such period between the First day of *January*, One thousand eight hundred and ninety-seven, and the Thirty-first day of *December*, One thousand eight hundred and ninety-seven, as the said Minister shall think proper.

Minister may vary Agreement.
