AN ACT to continue An Act to make temporary provision for the better Confinement and Classification of Prisoners imprisoned in the Gaols at Hobart Town and Launceston.

[25 February, 1858.]

W HEREAS by the Act of Council of the 19th Victoria, No. 22, it was PREAMBLE. enacted that the Act of Council of the 17th Victoria, No. 3, should continue and be in force until the end of the First Session of the Legislature of this Colony which should be holden in the year 1858, and no longer : And whereas it is expedient to continue the said Act for a further period : Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, that Continues the said Act of Council of the 17th Victoria, No. 3, shall continue and 17 Vict. No. 3, be in force until the end of the First Session of the Parliament of until Session of 1860. Tasmania which is held in the year 1860, and no longer.
