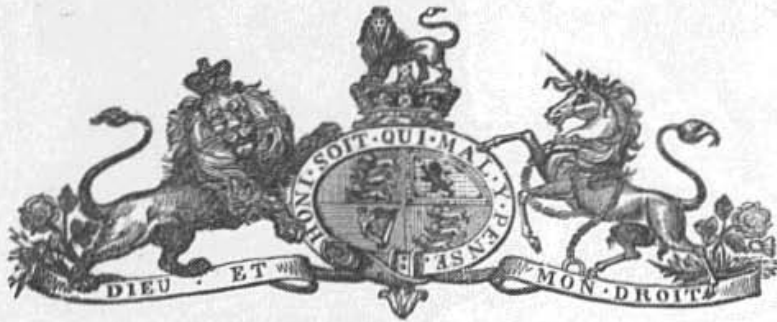

AN ACT to continue *An Act to make temporary provision for the better Confinement and Classification of Prisoners imprisoned in the Gaols at Hobart Town and Launceston.*

[25 February, 1858.]

WHEREAS by the Act of Council of the 19th *Victoria*, No. 22, it was enacted that the Act of Council of the 17th *Victoria*, No. 3, should continue and be in force until the end of the First Session of the Legislature of this Colony which should be holden in the year 1858, and no longer: And whereas it is expedient to continue the said Act for a further period: Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, that the said Act of Council of the 17th *Victoria*, No. 3, shall continue and be in force until the end of the First Session of the Parliament of *Tasmania* which is held in the year 1860, and no longer.
