

AN ACT to continue An Act to provide temporarily for the Protection of Imported Game. [18 October, 1870.]

WHEREAS by the Act of Parliament of the 29th Victoriæ, No. 22, PREAMBLE. it was amongst other things enacted that the said Act should continue 29 Vict. No. 22. and be in force until the end of the First Session of the Parliament of Tasmania which should be holden in the year 1870, and no longer: And whereas it is expedient to continue the said Act for a further period: Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, that the said Continues 29 Vict. Act of Parliament of the 29th Victoriæ, No. 22, shall continue and be in Session of 1875. force until the end of the First Session of the Parliament of Tasmania which is held in the year 1875 and no longer.
