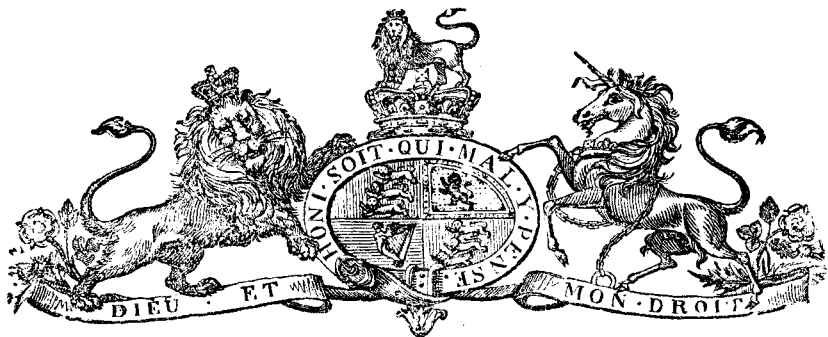

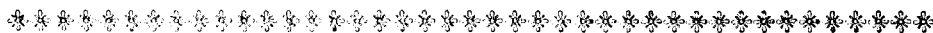

AN ACT to continue *An Act temporarily to make Provision for the Preservation and Propagation of Salmon in this Colony.*

[30 November, 1861.]

WHEREAS by the Act of Parliament of the 23rd *Victoria*, No. 9, it was amongst other things enacted that the said Act should continue and be in force until the end of the First Session of the Parliament of *Tasmania*, which should be holden in the year 1861, and no longer: And whereas it is expedient to continue the said Act for a further period: Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, that the said Act of Parliament of the 23rd *Victoria*, No. 9, shall continue and be in force until the end of the First Session of the Parliament of *Tasmania* which is held in the year 1863, and no longer.
