AN ACT to continue the Act of Council of Ordinance of this Island intituled An Act to repeal the Act of Council of this Island intituled An Act for the Regulation of Vehicles conveying Passengers for Hire within the Towns of this Island and to substitute other Provisions in lieu thereof.

WHEREAS an Act of Council or Ordinance of this Island was Preamble. Present in the twelfth year of the Reign of Her present Majesty Queen Victoria intituled An Act to repeal the Act of Council of this Island 12 Vict. No. 6. intituled An Act for the Regulation of Vehicles conveying Passengers for Hire within the Towns of this Island and to substitute other Provisions in lieu thereof by the Twenty-ninth Section whereof it was enacted that the said Act should continue in force until the end of the Session of the Legislative Council or Local Legislature of this Colony which should be holden in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty-one and no longer—AND WHEREAS it is expedient to continue the said Act—BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by His

12 Vict. No. 6 continued in force until Session of Council in 1855.
