

AN ACT to cause the Amount of Mortgage at present secured on the Toll-gate at Entally to be paid off. [22 October, 1869.]

WHEREAS it is expedient that the amount of Mortgage secured PREAMBLE. on the Tolls to be collected at the Toll-gate of Entally should be paid off: Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

From and after the passing of this Act all Tolls received by the Tolls to be applied Trustees of the Road District of Carrick at the Toll-gate situate at in payment of Entally shall be paid and applied in and towards the payment of any mortgage debt now existing upon security of such Tolls, and upon payment of every such debt and all interest due thereon Tolls shall be demanded at such Gate only in accordance with the provisions of "The Cross and Bye Roads Act, 1870."
