

AN ACT to continue "The Diseased Animals A.D. 1886. Importation Prevention Act."

[8 December, 1886.]

WHEREAS "The Diseased Animals Importation Prevention Act" PREAMBLE. will expire on the Thirty-first day of *December*, One thousand eight 47 Vict. No. 2. hundred and eighty-six: And whereas it is expedient to provide for the continuance of the said Act:

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 "The Diseased Animals Importation Prevention Act" shall be and 47 Vict. No. 2 the same is hereby continued in full force and effect until the Thirty-continued. first day of *December*, 1887: Provided nevertheless, all proceedings, civil or criminal, by the said Act authorised to be taken may be commenced or prosecuted after the said Thirty-first day of *December*, 1887.
