

AN ACT to entitle Charles Wright, formerly 1906. Superintendent in the Police Force of

Tasmania, to receive a Pension.

[25 October, 1906.]

WHEREAS Charles Wright, formerly a Superintendent in the PREAMBLE. Police Force of Tasmania, was, on the Second day of October, One Charles Wright. thousand eight hundred and fifty-four, appointed a Police Constable in the Police Force of Tasmania, and stationed in the District of New Norfolk:

And whereas on the formation of the Rural Municipality of Brighton, the said Charles Wright was, on the Nineteenth day of November, One thousand eight hundred and sixty-three, transferred to a position in the Police Force of that Municipality':

And whereas the said Charles Wright remained in the service of the said Municipality until the First day of January, One thousand eight hundred and ninety-nine, when he became a member of the

Police Force of Tasmania:

And whereas the said Charles Wright resigned his position of Superintendent in the Police Force of Tasmania on the Thirty-first day of March, One thousand eight hundred and ninety-nine:

Wright's Pension.

And whereas it is desirable that a pension should be paid to the said Charles Wright:

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Annual pension of £26 payable to Charles Wright.

1 There shall be payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund to the said *Charles Wright* an annual pension of Twenty-six Pounds during his life; and such pension shall be paid monthly, commencing from the First day of *July*, One thousand nine hundred and six.

Treasurer to pay pension upon Governor's Warrant. 2 The Governor shall from time to time issue his Warrant to the Treasurer for the payment of the said pension to the said Charles Wright, and the same shall thereupon be paid by the Treasurer to the said Charles Wright, or to such person as he, by writing under his hand, may appoint to receive the same.

In case of death, payment of proportion of pension to personal representatives. 3 It shall be lawful for the Governor, by Warrant under his hand, in case of the death of the said *Charles Wright* during the currency of any month, to direct payment to be made to his personal representatives of a proportionate part of such pension up to the day of his death.
