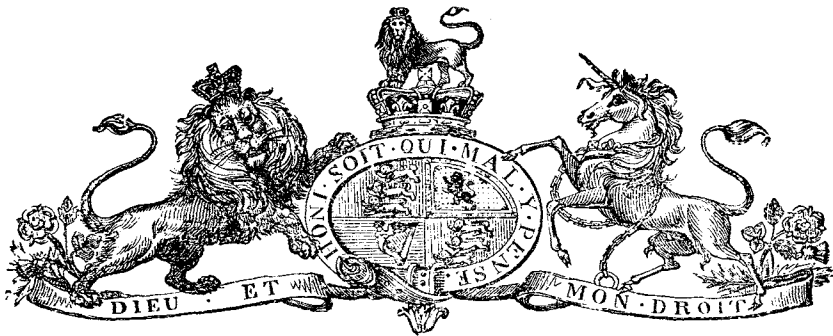

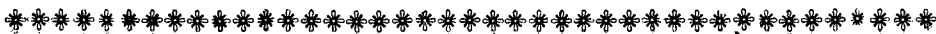

AN ACT to entitle Mrs. *Catherine Troy* to the benefit of *The Superannuation Act* upon her retirement from the Public Service of *Tasmania*. [1 December, 1899.]

A.D. 1899.

WHEREAS Mrs. *Catherine Troy* was, on the Thirteenth day of *October*, One thousand eight hundred and sixty-two, appointed in the Public Service of *Tasmania* :

PREAMBLE.

And whereas her services were dispensed with on the Thirty-first day of *December*, One thousand eight hundred and sixty-five, owing to the School in which she was in charge being closed on account of the number of scholars not being sufficient :

And whereas she was, after a lapse of Seven months, reappointed in the said Service, and has continued therein ever since :

And whereas it is desirable that she should be entitled to the benefit of *The Superannuation Act* upon her retirement from the said Service in the same manner as if her service had been continuous since the year One thousand eight hundred and sixty-two :

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 It shall be lawful for the Governor in Council to grant a Superannuation Allowance in accordance with the provisions of *The Superannuation Act* to Mrs. *Catherine Troy*, State School Teacher, upon her retirement from such office in the Public Service of the Colony, subject, however, to all the provisions of the said Act.
