AN ACT to entitle Mrs. Catherine Troy to A.D. 1899. the benefit of The Superannuation Act upon her retirement from the Public Service of Tasmania. [1 December, 1899.]

WHEREAS Mrs. Catherine Troy was, on the Thirteenth day of PREAMBLE. October, One thousand eight hundred and sixty-two, appointed in the Public Service of Tasmania:

And whereas her services were dispensed with on the Thirty-first day of *December*, One thousand eight hundred and sixty-five, owing to the School in which she was in charge being closed on account of the number of scholars not being sufficient :

And whereas she was, after a lapse of Seven months, reappointed in the said Service, and has continued therein ever since :

And whereas it is desirable that she should be entitled to the benefit of The Superannuation Act upon her retirement from the said Service in the same manner as if her service had been continuous since the year One thousand eight hundred and sixty-two:

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :--

1 It shall be lawful for the Governor in Council to grant a Super-Mrs. C. Troy to annuation Allowance in accordance with the provisions of The have benefit of Superannuation Act to Mrs. Catherine Troy, State School Teacher, <sup>24</sup> Vict. No. 15. upon her retirement from such office in the Public Service of the Colony, subject, however, to all the provisions of the said Act.
