

A.D. AN ACT to enable the Municipal Council of 1906. the Rural Municipality of Fingal to pay a Gratuity in a certain case, and for other [30 November, 1906.] purposes.

**D**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 The Municipal Council of the Rural Municipality of Fingal may Fingal Municipal grant to the widow of their late Council Clerk, Henry Lyne, deceased, any gratuity which to the Council may seem fit, in recognition of his faithful services; and they may pay the same out of the Municipal Fund of the Municipality. Any payment already made by the Council, Lyne, deceased, whether to the said Henry Lyne in his lifetime, or to his widow, as or or his widow. on account of a gratuity shall be deemed to have been duly authorised by law, and be valid.
