By His Excellency SIR JOHN FRANKLIN, Knight Commander of the Royal Hanoverian Guelphic Order, Knight of the Greek Order of the Redeemer, and a Captain in His Majesty's Royal Navy, Lieutenant-Governor of the Island of Van Diemen's Land and its Dependencies, with the advice of the Legislative Council.

AN ACT to extend to this Colony a Statute passed for regulating the Admeasurement of Vessels.

WHEREAS an Act was passed in England in the fifth and sixth year of His Majesty's reign intituled "An Act to regulate the Admeasurement of the Tonnage and Burthen of the Merchant Shipping of the United Kingdom" and it is expedient to extend the provisions of the said Act to this Colony—

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by His Excellency Sir JOHN FRANKLIN Lieutenant-Governor of the Island of Van Diemen's Land and its Dependencies with the advice of the Legislative Council that from and after the passing of this Act the said recited Act of the fifth and sixth year of His Majesty shall extend to and be in force within this Island and its Dependencies and the several provisions thereof shall

The said Act (*Admeasurement of Vessels*) extended to this Colony.
