

AN ACT to establish Uniformity of Weight in the Sale of Flour and Grain.

[4 December, 1857.]

W HEREAS it is desirable to establish Uniformity in the Weight PREAMBLE. by which Flour and Grain are sold in this Colony: Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:-

1 The term "Ton," "Hundredweight," and "Quarter," used with Number of reference to Flour, and the term "Bushel" used with reference to Wheat, Oats, Barley, Maize, Bran, Beans, Peas, Tares, Rye, and Grass-seed, &c. of Flour and shall respectively mean and intend the number of pounds Avoirdupois Bushel of Wheat, Weight mentioned in the Schedule.

&c. to consist.

2 No person who, after the commencement of this Act, sells any Persons not Flour, Wheat, Oats, Barley, Maize, Bran, Beans, Peas, Tares, Rye, or bound to deliver Grass-seed, shall be bound or compellable to deliver any greater weight greater weight than that specified. per Ton, Hundredweight, or Quarter of such Flour, or per bushel of such Wheat, Oats, Barley, Maize, Bran, Beans, Peas, Tares, Rye, or Grass-seed, than that specified in the Schedule.

3 This Act shall commence and take effect on the First day of Commencement of Act. January, 1858.
