

AN ACT to further amend "The Roads Act, A.D. 1889. 1884." [5 December, 1889.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :--

1 The Fourth Section of "The Roads Act, 1884," shall be and the Declaration of same is hereby repealed, and in lieu thereof the following shall, from Main Roads. the commencement of this Act, be deemed to be and may be cited as the Fourth Section of the said Act; that is to say :-

"(1.) Such Roads as Parliament shall annually determine to be "Main Roads of Tasmania shall be deemed to be Main Roads under "and for the purposes of this Part of this Act, notwithstanding that "portions of some of such Roads are situated within the boundaries of "certain Road Districts.

"(2.) Whenever in any year no provision is made by Parliament "for the maintenance as a Main Road of *Tasmania* of any Road or "Roads or portion of a Road theretofore maintained by the Board of "the District in which the same is situate, or under the direction of "the Commissioner as a Main Road, such Road or Roads or portion of "a Road shall thereupon cease to be a Main Road under and for the "purposes of this Part of this Act."
