

AN ACT to further amend "The Railway A.D. 1889. Construction Act, 1885."

[9 November, 1889.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

In this Act the expression "The said Act" means "The Railway Interpretation.
49 Vict. No. 41. Construction Act, 1885."

2 Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in Section Minister to cause Four of the said Act, it shall be lawful for the Minister to cause to be certain Works to executed under the said Act certain improvements and additions towards be executed on Sorell Railway. the further completion of the Line of Railway to be known as the Sorell Railway, and for the purpose of enabling higher speed and weight of trains to be run on the said Railway, at a cost not exceeding Thirtyseven thousand eight hundred Pounds.

- 3 The costs of the said Works mentioned in the preceding Section Defrayment of shall be defrayed out of the moneys to be provided by Parliament for cost of Works. that purpose.
- 4 This Act and the said Act, save as amended by this Act, shall be Acts to be read read and construed together as one Act. together.
