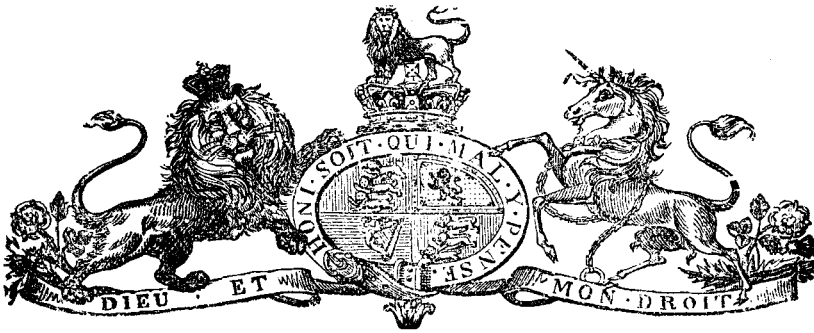

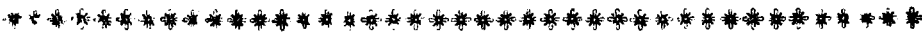

AN ACT to further amend *The Contagious A.D. 1894.*  
*Diseases (Cattle) Act, 1861.*  
[1 August, 1894.]

**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

**1** In Section One, lines six and seven, and in Section Four, line two, of *The Contagious Diseases (Cattle) Act, 1861*, in place of the words "*Port Arthur*" the word "*Strahan*" is hereby substituted ; and after the commencement hereof the importation and landing of Cattle may, subject to the provisions contained in the said Act or any Amendment thereof, be permitted to take place at *Hobart, Launceston, and Strahan*, and not elsewhere, subject to such restrictions and regulations as to the Governor in Council shall seem fit. Amendment of Sects. 1 and 4 of 25 Vict. No. 4.

**2** The said Act and every Act amending the same, as amended by this Act, and this Act shall be read and construed together as one Act. Acts to be read together.
