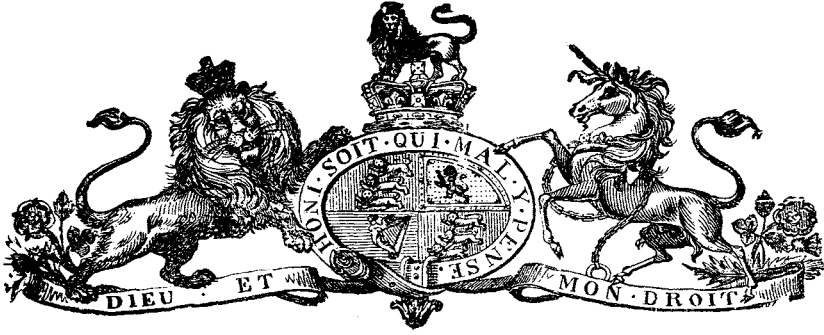

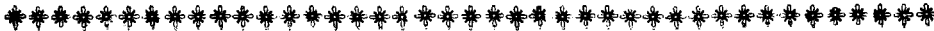

AN ACT to further amend "The Income Tax Act, 1894." [8 December, 1899.] A.D. 1899.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 The words "until the Thirty-first day of *December*, One thousand eight hundred and ninety-nine," in the last two lines in Section Three of "The Income Tax Act, 1898," are hereby repealed, and the said Section shall be read and construed as if the words "until the Thirty-first day of *December*, One thousand nine hundred and two" had been inserted therein.
