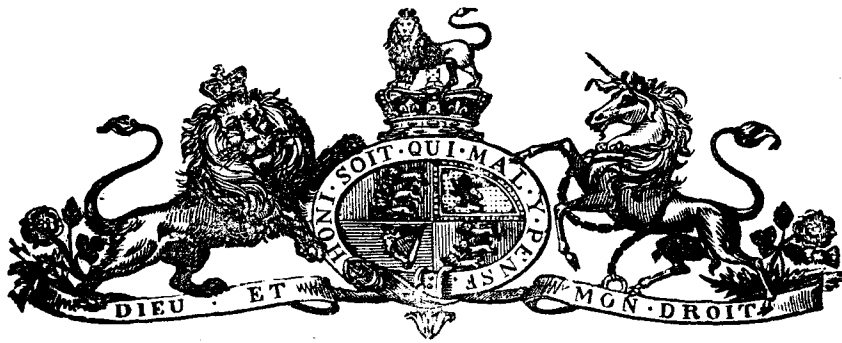

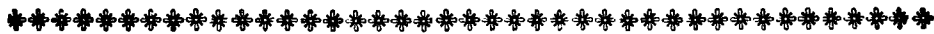

AN ACT to fix the Salaries of the Responsible Ministers of the Crown. [21 August, 1882.] A.D. 1882.

WHEREAS it is expedient to increase and fix the Salaries of the Responsible Ministers of the Crown : PREAMBLE.

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 From and after the Thirty-first day of *December*, 1882, there shall be paid and applied out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, as the Salaries of the persons holding the offices named in the Schedule, the sums set opposite such offices in the said Schedule ; and the provisions of Section Thirty of *The Constitutional Act* shall be applicable in respect of such sums in the same manner as if they were inserted in the Schedule B. of that Act instead of the sums therein specified as Salaries in respect of certain of the said offices. 2 The Act of the Parliament of *Tasmania* of the 30th *Victoria*, No. 9, and so much of the Act of the Parliament of *Tasmania* of the 33rd *Victoria*, No. 4, as provides that the person filling the Office of Minister of Lands and Works shall receive a Salary of Seven hundred Pounds per annum, shall be repealed from and after the Thirty-first day of *December*, 1882 ; but such repeal shall not affect the payment of any sum of money payable thereunder before such repeal takes effect. Any person who shall, in conjunction with any Ministerial Office mentioned in the Schedule, hold the position of Premier, shall be entitled to receive an additional £200 per annum during the time he continues to hold such position of Premier in conjunction with a Ministerial Office.
