

AN ACT to make further provision for the A.D. 1901. Execution of a certain Public Work.

[7 November, 1901.]

WHEREAS by the Act of Parliament of Tasmania, 63 Victoria, PREAMBLE. No. 41, provision is made for the construction of a "New Post and Telegraph Office, Hobart," at a cost not exceeding the sum of Eighteen thousand Pounds:

And whereas by the Act of Parliament of *Tasmania* 64 *Victoriæ* No. 63, Schedule (1.), Item 356, provision is made for the expenditure of the additional sum of Eight thousand Pounds upon the construction of the said building:

And whereas the lowest Tender for the construction of the said Building greatly exceeds the said amount:

And whereas it is desirable to make further provision for construction

of the said Building:

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

## Public Work Execution.

Additional vote for Post and Telegraph Office, Hobart. 1 It shall be lawful for the Minister of Lands and Works to cause to be expended upon the construction of a "New Post and Telegraph Office, Hobart," the sum of Eight thousand Pounds, in addition to the amount provided by the Acts of Parliament, 63 Victoriæ, No. 41, and 64 Victoriæ, No. 63, and such sum of Eight thousand Pounds shall be defrayed out of moneys to be provided by Parliament for that purpose.
