

AN ACT to make provision for the Im- A.D. 1894. Goods into Tasmania for portation of exhibition at the Tasmanian International Exhibition, and for the Sale of Liquors at such Exhibition, and for other purposes.

[3 September, 1894.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:-

1—(1.) It shall be lawful for the Governor in Council from time to Governor in time to make and from time to time to amend and repeal such Regu- Council may lations as he sees fit for regulating the importation of articles, goods, wares, and merchandise for exhibition at the *Tasmanian* International importation of Exhibition to be held at *Hobert* in years 1894 and 1895 Exhibition to be held at *Hobart* in years 1894 and 1895.

(2.) Subject to the conditions contained in any Regulations which exhibition. may from time to time be made by the Governor in Council and Exhibits may be published in the Gazette, and on receiving a statutory declaration admitted free. from any importer, exhibitor, or his agent of his intention to exhibit any articles specified in such declaration at such Exhibition, it shall be lawful for the Treasurer, by order under his hand, to authorise the admission into Tasmania without payment of any Duties of Customs of any such articles so intended as exhibits, and to be stored at any such Exhibition.

Importation of Goods for Exhibition Regulation.

Permits for sale of liquor at Tasmanian Exhibition, 1894. 2 Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in any Law, the Directors of "The *Tasmanian* Exhibition Association" may, upon such terms and subject to such conditions as they may approve, sell, or issue Permits to sell, by retail, on the premises of the Exhibition in *Hobart* any wines, spirits, ale, porter, cider, or other fermented or spirituous liquors.

Provided always, that the Permits issued by the Directors as aforesaid do not exceed Four in number, and that such Permits be only issued to and held by a person or persons holding a Public-house Licence in *Tasmania*.

Australian Wine

Permits may be issued by Directors.

3 The said Directors in like manner may sell, or issue Permits to sell, by retail, Australian wines on the premises of the said Exhibition in Hobart.

Provided always, that the Permits issued by the Directors do not exceed in number more than Eight; and further, that such Permits may be issued to any person or persons without reference to the holding of a Public-house Licence.

Permits to be only in force during the Exhibition.

4 The authority hereinbefore given to Directors to sell, and to issue Permits to sell, liquors or Australian wines shall not have any force or effect before the day of the opening of the Exhibition nor after the closing; and the hours of selling shall be from the opening of the Exhibition to the public until the closing of the same each day, and shall be continued for the Six week days only.

Australian wines admitted Duty free.

5 Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in any Act, the Treasurer may permit any Australian wine imported for consumption on the premises of the Exhibition to be landed in Tasmania free of all Customs and Primage Duties.
