AN ACT to make provision for the Issue of A.D. 1879.
Licences to fish for Salmon and Trout.
[10 June, 1879.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in *The Salmon Act, 1865*, "*The Salmon Act, 1878*," or "*The Trout Act, 1878*," it shall be lawful for the Governor in Council to make Regulations providing for the issue of licences to fish for, catch, or kill Salmon and Trout, or Salmon or Trout, for such periods, not being within the close seasons for Salmon and Trout respectively, and upon the payment of such fees and generally upon such terms as the Governor in Council may prescribe by such Regulations. Governor in Council may make Regulations for the issue of licences to fish for Salmon and Trout.

2 All licences issued and all moneys paid for licences under the said Acts or any of them before the commencement of this Act shall be deemed to have been lawfully issued and paid, anything in the said Acts to the contrary notwithstanding. Licences issued and moneys paid for licences to be deemed good.

3 This Act shall be read as one with the Acts hereinbefore mentioned. Acts to be read together.
