AN ACT to make provision for the Issue of A.D. 1879. Licences to fish for Salmon and Trout. [10 June, 1879.]

LE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in *The* Governor in Salmon Act, 1865, "The Salmon Act, 1878," or "The Trout Act, Council may 1878," it shall be lawful for the Governor in Council to make Regulations for the issue of licences to fish for, catch, or kill Salmon and Trout, or Salmon or Trout, for such periods, not being for Salmon and within the close seasons for Salmon and Trout respectively, and upon the payment of such for and generally upon such towards as the Governor in Trout. the payment of such fees and generally upon such terms as the Governor in Council may prescribe by such Regulations.

2 All licences issued and all moneys paid for licences under the said Licences issued Acts or any of them before the commencement of this Act shall be and moneys paid deemed to have been lawfully issued and paid, anything in the said for licences to be deemed good. Acts to the contrary notwithstanding.

3 This Act shall be read as one with the Acts hereinbefore mentioned. Acts to be read together.
