AN ACT to make provision for the substitution of certain Memorials for the Registration of certain Deeds for certain other Memorials which have been destroyed by Fire.

[1 August, 1894.]

WHEREAS on the Twenty-first day of *February*, One thousand eight hundred and ninety-four, certain Memorials, numbered from $\frac{9}{1201}$ to $\frac{9}{1400}$, both numbers inclusive, for the registration, in pursuance of *The Registration Act* and its Amendments, of certain Conveyances, Deeds, and other Instruments, which had before then been duly registered under the said Acts, or some or one of them, were accidentally destroyed by fire :

PREAMBLE.

And whereas it is necessary to provide that certain other Memorials should be substituted for such Memorials as aforesaid, in order that the date of the Registration of the Conveyances, Deeds, and other Instruments, severally and respectively described and set forth in such first-mentioned Memorials, should not be affected by the destruction of such Memorials, and that evidence of the contents of the said destroyed Memorials should be preserved :

And whereas certain other Memorials have been duly sworn and delivered, or may be hereafter sworn and delivered, into the Office of the Registrar of Deeds in substitution for such Memorials so destroyed by fire as aforesaid, and such other Memorials are now or may hereafter be numbered $\frac{9}{1201}$ to $\frac{9}{1400}$, both numbers inclusive :

Memorials' Substitution.

A.D. 1894.

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

Certain Memorials substituted for others destroyed by fire.

1 All Memorials for the registration of certain Conveyances, Deeds, Wills, and other Instruments now or hereafter deposited in the Office of the Registrar of Deeds in substitution for the Memorials so destroyed by fire as aforesaid, and numbered $\frac{9}{1201}$ to $\frac{9}{1400}$, both numbers inclusive, shall be deemed and taken to have been duly deposited in the said Office under the said Acts, or some or one of them, to and for all intents and purposes whatsoever ; and where there shall be endorsed upon any Conveyance, Deed, or other Instrument a receipt for a Memorial bearing one of the said numbers and signed by the Registrar of Deeds or Deputy Registrar of Deeds in pursuance of Section Six of the Act of Council of the 8th *George IV.*, No. 5, such receipt shall be held to apply to the said substituted Memorial bearing the said number mentioned in the said receipt and now or hereafter deposited in the said Office, and the said substituted Memorial shall have the same force and effect as, and shall be deemed to be, the original Memorial for which it was substituted.

Acts to be read together.

2 The Acts set forth in the Schedule shall be read and construed together with this Act.
