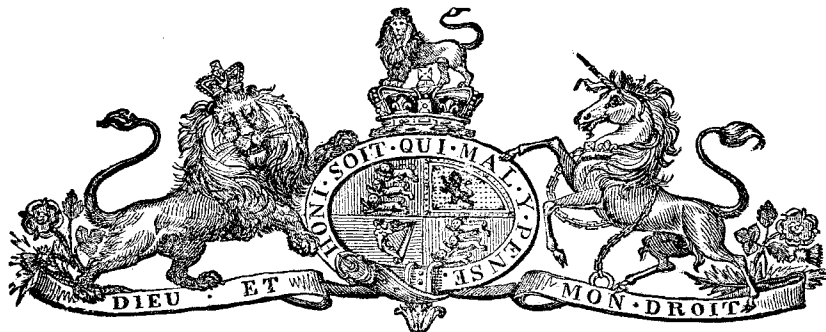

AN ACT to make permanent *The Penalties' Distribution Act.* [25 February, 1858.]

WHEREAS by Section 4 of *The Penalties' Distribution Act* it was enacted that the said Act should continue in force until the 1st day of *August*, 1858: And whereas it is expedient that the said Act should be continued and made permanent: Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, that *The Penalties' Distribution Act* shall continue in force after the 1st day of *August*, 1858, and shall be permanent, anything in the said Act to the contrary notwithstanding.
