

AN ACT to make permanent The Penalties' Distribution Act. [25 February, 1858.]

WHEREAS by Section 4 of The Penalties' Distribution Act it PREAMBLE. was enacted that the said Act should continue in force until the 1st 20 Vict. No. 27. day of August, 1858: And whereas it is expedient that the said Act should be continued and made permanent: Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, that The Penalties' Distribution Act shall continue The Penalties' in force after the 1st day of August, 1858, and shall be permanent, Distribution Act anything in the said Act to the contrary notwithstanding. anything in the said Act to the contrary notwithstanding.
