

AN ACT to make temporary provision for carrying on and working the Launceston and Western Railway. [19 August, 1872.]

WHEREAS The Launceston and Western Railway Company, PREAMBLE. Limited, have surrendered to the Governor in Council the Line of Railway and Works constructed by the said Company, with the Rolling Stock and appliances connected therewith, and all Buildings and Erections erected by the said Company for the purpose of conducting and carrying on the Traffic and Business of the said Railway; and it is expedient to make temporary provision for carrying on the Traffic and Business of the said Railway:

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:--

1 All powers and authorities for carrying on and working the Powers and Au-Launceston and Western Railway which by any Act are vested in Company to be or exercisable by The Launceston and Western Railway Company, exercisable by (limited,) may be used and exercised by the Governor in Council as Governor in fully and effectually in all respects as if the Governor in Council had Council. been named in any such Act instead of the said Company.

2 All Bye-laws made by the said Company by virtue of any Act Bye-laws made by shall be deemed to have been made by the Governor in Council, and may be enforced in the same manner as if the Governor in Council had made by Governor in the said Act and Bye-laws instead of the said Company.

The Governor in Council may appoint any person in whose name all proceedings may be taken for the recovery of moneys and penalties, or

for any purpose connected with the said Railway and Works, either under the said Bye-laws or any Act relating to the said Railway.

Appropriation of moneys provided by Parliament.

3 Out of any moneys which may be provided by Parliament for the purposes of the Launceston and Western Railway, it shall be lawful for the Colonial Treasurer to pay any debts due by The Launceston and Western Railway Company, (limited,) whether for interest, wages, or otherwise, and to defray any expenses which may have been incurred, or which may be hereafter incurred, in repairing, altering, or maintaining the said Railway, or any Buildings, Works, Rolling Stock, and appliances connected therewith.

Duration of Act.

4 This Act shall continue and be in force until the end of the next Session of the Parliament of *Tasmania* and no longer.
