

AN ACT to provide for an Increase in the A.D. 1896. amount of Pension payable to Lawrence M'Inerney. [23 October, 1896.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 Notwithstanding anything to the contrary, it shall be lawful for Appropriation of the Treasurer to pay, by way of pension, in the year One thousand eight hundred and ninety-six and every succeeding year, to Lawrence Pension to Lawrence M'Inerney, late Attendant and Messenger, Hospital for Insane, New Norfolk, the sum of Eleven Pounds Thirteen Shillings and Two Pence; and such sum shall be in addition to and not in diminution of any Superannuation Allowance granted in accordance with the provisions of The Superannuation Act to the said Lawrence M'Inerney.
