

AN ACT to provide for Loans to certain A.D. 1900. Local Bodies, in accordance with the provisions of "The Local Public Works Loans Act, 1890." [15 *December*, 1900.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 It shall be lawful for the Governor in Council to grant, in Loans may be accordance with the provisions of "The Local Public Works Loans granted. Act, 1890," as Loans to the several Local Bodies named in the Schedule hereto, the sums of money therein set opposite the names of the Local Bodies, for the purposes mentioned in the said Schedule; and such moneys shall be defrayed out of moneys to be provided by Parliament for that purpose: Provided that it shall not be necessary to lay before both Houses of Parliament plans and specifications of any proposed works, nor the report of the Engineer-in-Chief thereon, as provided in Section Two of the said Act; but before any part of the said sums is advanced to the several Local Bodies named in the Schedule hereto plans and specifications of the proposed works shall be submitted to and approved by the Governor in Council.
