

AN ACT to provide for the Alteration of A.D. 1904. certain Salaries fixed by Law, for and during the Six months ending the Thirtieth day of [11 November, 1904.] June, 1905.

W HEREAS it is expedient and necessary for and during the Six PREAMBLE. months ending the Thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and five, that a reduction and alteration should be made in certain Salaries now fixed by Law:

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 In lieu of the Salaries mentioned in the Schedule to the Act of Salaries payable the Parliament of Tasmania, intituled "An Act to fix the Salaries of to Ministers. the responsible Ministers of the Crown," so far as relates to the period 46 Vict. No. 9 of Six months ending the Thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and five, there shall be paid and applied out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the said period of Six months ending the

Alteration of Salaries fixed by Law.

Thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and five, as the Salaries of the persons holding the offices named in the Schedule hereto, the sums set opposite such offices in the said Schedule; and the provisions of Section Thirty of The Constitution Act shall be applicable in respect of such sums in he same manner as if they were inserted in Schedule B. of that Act instead of the sums therein specified as Salaries in respect of certain of the said offices.
