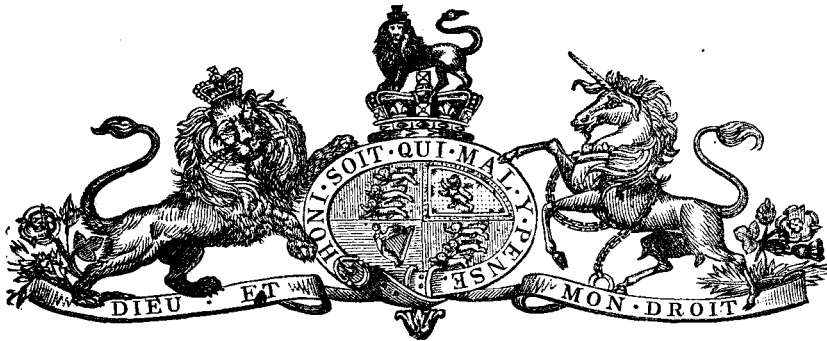

AN ACT to provide for the Appropriation A.D. 1890.  
of certain Sums of Money expended in  
the purchase of Land for State Schools.

[28 November, 1890.]

**W**HEREAS prior to the passing of "The Education Act, 1885," PREAMBLE.  
certain sums of money to the amount of £2248 were expended in the  
purchase of Land as Sites for State Schools, and such sums are charged  
in the Books of the Treasury to a Suspense Account :

And whereas it is desirable that such sums should be charged against  
moneys which have since been voted by Parliament for the purchase of  
Land and the erection of State Schools thereon :

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*,  
by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and  
House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

**1** It shall be lawful for the Treasurer to pay the several sums of Appropriation of  
moneys voted by  
Parliament.  
money specified in the Schedule hereto out of moneys which have been  
from time to time voted by Parliament for the purchase of Land and  
the erection of State Schools thereon, under the provisions of "The  
Education Act, 1885," anything in any Act to the contrary notwith-  
standing.
