### AN ACT to provide for the Construction A.D. 1886. of Telegraph Lines and the Extension of Telephonic Communication.

[8 December, 1886.]

DE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :----

1 It shall be lawful for the Treasurer, out of moneys to be provided £3500 payable by Parliament for that purpose, to advance and pay any sum or sums of for Telegraph money, not exceeding in the whole the sum of Three thousand Five Lines, &c. hundred Pounds, in and towards the construction of Telegraph Lines, under The Electric Telegraph Act, and the extension of Telephonic 20 Vict. No. 22. -communication, under "The Telephone Act, 1882." 46 Vict. No. 5.
