

AN ACT to provide for the Erection and A.D. 1880. Construction of certain Public Buildings. [1 November, 1880.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 It shall be lawful for the Minister of Lands and Works to cause Minister of Lands the several Works mentioned in the Schedule to be erected, constructed, to cause Works to and completed at a cost for each separate Work not exceeding the be constructed. amount therein set opposite such Work.
