## AN ACT to provide for the Erection and Con-4 .D. 1882. struction of certain Public Buildings. [9 October, 1882.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :---
