By His Excellency SIR WILLIAM THOMAS DENISON, Knight, Lieutenant-Governor of the Island of Van Diemen's Land and its Dependencies, with the Advice of the Legislative Council.

AN ACT to provide for the Exemption from Wharfage Dues of Metallic Ores in certain Cases.

WHEREAS an Act of Council or Ordinance of this Island was PREAMBLE. passed in the second year of the reign of Her present Majesty Queen VICTORIA intituled An Act to consolidate and amend the Laws for the 2 Vict. No. 5. Preservation of the Ports and the Regulation of Shipping within the same by the twenty-second section whereof certain rates and charges are imposed and made payable for Wharfage on goods entered to be landed at any Port in this Colony-AND WHEREAS a certain other Act of Council or Ordinance of this Island was passed in the second year of the reign of Her said present Majesty intituled An Act to 2 Vict. No. 13. amend the Laws for the Regulation of the Customs of Van Diemen's Land and its Dependencies by the sixteenth section whereof it is amongst other things provided that goods may be unladen from any ship or vessel at any place in this Colony at which no Officer of the Customs is appointed to attend such unlading by virtue of a sufferance granted by the Collector and Controller of Customs for the unlading of such goods at such place—AND WHEREAS it is expedient to encourage the importation into this Colony of Metallic Ores for the purposes of smelting by providing for the remission thereon in certain cases of such Wharfage Dues as aforesaid-BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by His Excellency SIR WILLIAM THOMAS DENISON Knight Lieutenant-Governor of the Island of Van Diemen's Land and its Dependencies by and with the advice of the Legislative Council of the said Island that from and after the time when this Act shall come into Enables Lieuoperation it shall be lawful for the Lieutenant-Governor or person for tenant-Governor. the time being administering the Government of this Island and he is to remit Wharfage

Ores in certain cases.

Duty on Metallic hereby authorised and empowered with the advice of the Executive Council of this Island by writing under his hand from time to time to direct that the Wharfage Dues by the said firstly recited Act imposed upon and made payable in respect of Metallic Ores imported into this Colony which shall be so unladen at any such place as aforesaid by virtue of any such sufferance as aforesaid shall be remitted where such metallic ores shall be so imported for the purposes of smelting and not otherwise and the receipt by the said Collector of Customs of such writing shall be a sufficient warrant and authority for the remission by him of such Wharfage Dues on such Metallic Ores so imported and unladen as aforesaid and such Wharfage Dues on all Metallic Ores which shall be specified in and by any such writing shall accordingly be remitted and no such Dues shall be imposed upon or be payable in respect thereof any thing in the said firstly recited Act to the contrary in any wise notwithstanding.
