

AN ACT to provide for the Execution of A.D. 1882. certain Works for the Defence of the Colony of Tasmania. [9 October, 1882.7]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 It shall be lawful for the Governor in Council to cause the several Governor in Works for the Defence of the Colony mentioned in the Schedule to Council to cause be constructed and completed, at a cost for each separate Work not works to be constructed. exceeding the amount therein set opposite such work.

2 It shall be lawful for the Governor in Council to cause to be Governor in provided the several articles, materials, matters, and things necessary for Council to the Defence of the Colony which are mentioned in the said Schedule, vided certain at a cost for the same respectively not exceeding that set forth in the articles, &c. said Schedule.

3 The cost of such works, articles, materials, matters, and things Defrayment of shall be defrayed out of the moneys to be hereafter provided by Parlia- cost of works. ment for that purpose.
