

AN ACT to provide for the Reduction of A.D. 1896. certain Salaries and annual Payments fixed by Law, for and during the Year 1897.

[13 November, 1896.]

WHEREAS it is expedient and necessary for and during the Year PREAMBLE. One thousand eight hundred and ninety-seven, that a reduction should be

made in certain Salaries and annual payments now fixed by Law:

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 In lieu of the salaries mentioned in the Schedule to the Act of Salaries payable the Parliament of Tasmania, intituled "An Act to fix the Salaries of the Responsible Ministers of the Crown," there shall be paid and applied out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the year One thousand eight hundred and ninety-seven, as the Salaries of the persons holding the offices named in the Schedule (1.) hereto, the sums set opposite such offices in the said Schedule (1.); and the provisions of opposite such offices in the said Schedule (1.); and the provisions of Section Thirty of *The Constitution Act* shall be applicable in respect 18 Vict. No. 17. of such sums in the same manner as if they were inserted in Schedule B. of that Act instead of the sums therein specified as Salaries in respect of certain of the said offices.

### Reduction of Salaries fixed by Law.

Salaries payable to Officers of the Executive Council and Parliament under 46 Vict. No. 10. 2 In lieu of the Salaries mentioned in the Schedule (1.) to the Act of the Parliament of *Tasmania*, intituled "An Act to fix the Salaries payable to the Officers of the Executive Council and of the Parliament of *Tasmania*," there shall be paid and applied out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the year One thousand eight hundred and ninety-seven, as the Salaries of the persons holding the offices named in the Schedule (2.) hereto, the sums set forth opposite such offices in the said Schedule (2.).

Establishment Agent-General for the year 1897.

3 There shall and may be paid and applied out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund for and during the year One thousand eight hundred and ninety-seven, a sum not exceeding One thousand one hundred and forty Pounds as and for the Establishment of the Agent-General for Tasmania in the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland and elsewhere, notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in Section Five of "The Agent-General's Act, 1885," or the Schedule to that Act.

Reimbursement of Members of Parliament.

4 Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in the Act of the Parliament of Tasmania of the 54 Victoriæ, No. 20, every Member of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, except as mentioned in the Fourth Section of the said Act, shall for and during the year One thousand eight hundred and ninety-seven, be entitled to receive the sum of Fifty Pounds only as reimbursement of his expenses in relation to his attendance in the discharge of his Parliamentary duties, and such amount shall be payable to Members in two sums of Twenty-five Pounds each, subject to the conditions contained in the Act of the Parliament of Tasmania of the 55 Victoriæ, No. 29, notwithstanding anything to the contrary in that Act contained.

Salary of Solicitor-General for the year 1897. 5 There shall be paid and payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund for and in respect of the Salary of the Solicitor-General for and during the year One thousand eight hundred and ninety-seven the sum of Four hundred and twenty-eight Pounds, notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in the Act of the Parliament of Tasmania, intituled "An Act to increase the Salary of the Solicitor-General."

Appropriation for Council of University. 53 Vict. No. 41. 6 In lieu of the sum of Four thousand Pounds appropriated by the Twenty-second Section of "The Tasmanian University Act" to be paid by the Treasurer to the Council of the University in each year, there shall be paid in and for the year One thousand eight hundred and ninety-seven the sum of Two thousand five hundred Pounds.
