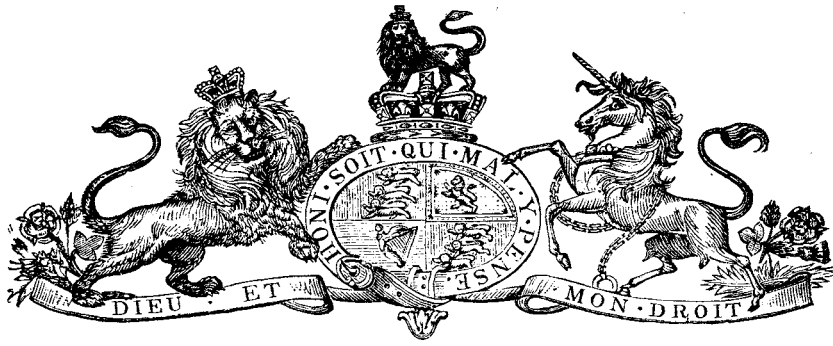

ANNO QUINQUAGESIMO-NONO

AN ACT to provide for the Sale and Disposal of certain Crown Land in the Town of *Strahan*. [24 October, 1895.] A.D. 1895.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 It shall be lawful for the Commissioner of Crown Lands to sell by private contract to *Edward Thomas Miles* the land described in the Schedule hereto for the sum of Two hundred Pounds sterling, to be paid in cash within Six months from the date of this Act. Land in Schedule to be sold to *E. T. Miles*.

And upon payment of such sum of money the Governor is hereby authorised, in the name and on behalf of Her Majesty, to convey and alienate to the said *Edward Thomas Miles*, in fee simple or for any less estate or interest, the piece of land set forth in the said Schedule.

2 In the event of the said *Edward Thomas Miles* not purchasing the lots of land described in the Schedule hereto as hereinbefore provided, it shall be lawful for the Commissioner of Crown Lands to sell such land in accordance with the provisions of "The Crown Lands Act, 1890." In event of no sale, land to be sold under provisions of 54 Vict. No. 8.

SCHEDULE.

TOWN OF STRAHAN.

LOT 8, SECTION V.I. 0A. 1R. 12P. OR THEREABOUTS.

Bounded on the north west by four chains and twenty-four links or thereabouts south-westerly in two bearings along Lots 6 and 7 purchased by Richard Symmons commencing at the north-east angle of the first-mentioned lot, on the south by one chain and sixty links or thereabouts easterly along Innes-street, and thence on the south east by three chains and fifty links or thereabouts north-easterly in two bearings to the point of commencement.
