## No. 33.

AN ACT to provide for the Sale and Disposal a.1. 1899. of certain Crown Land in the Town of Strahan.<br>[24 October, 1895.]

Barted bo His Excellency the Governor of $S$ smania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Comencil and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :-

1 It shall be lawful for the Commissioner of Crown Lands to sell Land in by private contract to Edward Thomas Miles the land described in Schedule to the Schedule hereto for the sum of Two hundred Pounds sterling, be sold to to be paid in cash within Six months from the date of this Act.

And upon payment of such sum of money the (iovernor is hereby authorised, in the name and on behalf of Her Majesty, to convey and alienate to the said Edward Thomas Miles, in fee simple or for any less estate or interest, the piece of land set forth in the said Schedule.

2 In the event of the said Edward Thomus Miles not purchasing In event of no the lots of land described in the Schedule hereto as hereinbefore sale, Jand to be provided, it shall be lawful for the Commissioner of Crown Lands to sold under sell such land in accordance with the provisions of "The Crown Lands provisions of Act, 1890."

## SCHEDULE.

TOWN OF STRAHAN.
Lot 8, Section V.1. OA. 1r. 12p. or thereabouts.
Bounded on the north west by four chains and twenty-four links or thereabouts south-westerly in two bearings along Lots 6 and 7 purchased by Richard Symmons commencing at the north-east angle of the first-mentioned lot, on the south by one chain and sixty links or thereabouts easterly along Innes-street, and thence on the south east by three chains and fifty links or thereabouts north-easterly in two bearings to the point of commencement.
