By His Excellency COLONEL GEORGE ARTHUR Lieutenant Governor of the Island of Van Diemen's Land and its Dependencies with the advice of the Legislative Council.

An Act to postpone until the first day of April next the commencement of the Act for establishing Standard Weights and measures.

WHEREAS by the said Act for establishing Standard Weights and Measures passed on the twenty seventh day of September last cortain Standard Weights and Measures were established.

AND IT WAS ENACTED that after the first day of January next it should not be lawful for any person to bargain sell or deliver any goods merchandize or other thing by any other than weights or measures agreeing therewith.

AND WHEREAS it hath been found impracticable to cause a sufficient number of Copies and Models of such new Standard Weights and Measures to be made by the said first day of January AND it is therefore expedient to postpone the time of the commencement of the said Act:—

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by His Excellency Colonel GEORGE ARTHUR Lieutenant Governor of the Island of Van Diemen's land and its Dependencies with the advice of the Legislative Council that the said Act for establishing Standard Weights and Measures shall not take effect until the first day of April now next on and from which day the said Act shall commence and come into operation and not before.
