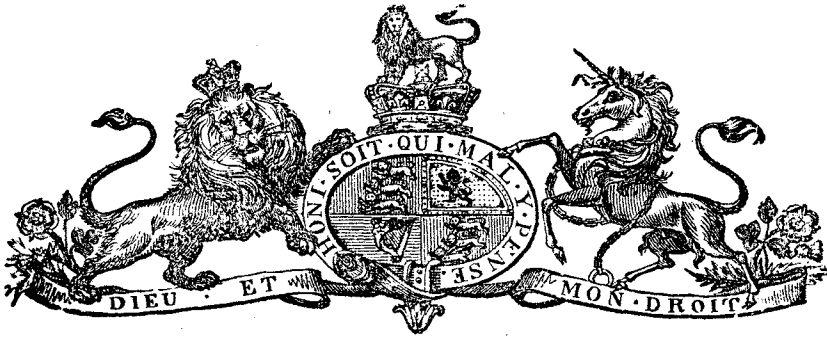

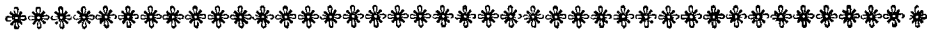

AN ACT to repeal *An Act to alter the Fees payable on obtaining Probate and Letters of Administration, and to levy certain Sums on Estates administered by the Curator of Intestate Estates.* [21 September, 1864.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 The Act of the Parliament of *Tasmania* of the 21st *Victoria*, No. 37, is hereby repealed: Provided that any person who shall have paid fees under the said Act, 21st *Victoria*, No. 37, shall, notwithstanding the passing of this Act, and when he could otherwise have claimed the same, be entitled to the benefit of the provisions contained in the 2nd Section of the said Act, 21st *Victoria*, No. 37. Repeal of 21 Vict. No. 37.

2 After the passing of this Act, any person applying for Probate of any Will or Letters of Administration, and providing the necessary documents for obtaining the same, shall obtain the same without any fee or charge whatsoever. Fees on Probate of Will or Letters of Administration abolished, when documents provided.

3 This Act shall come into force and take effect on and after the First day of *January*, 1865. Commencement of Act.
