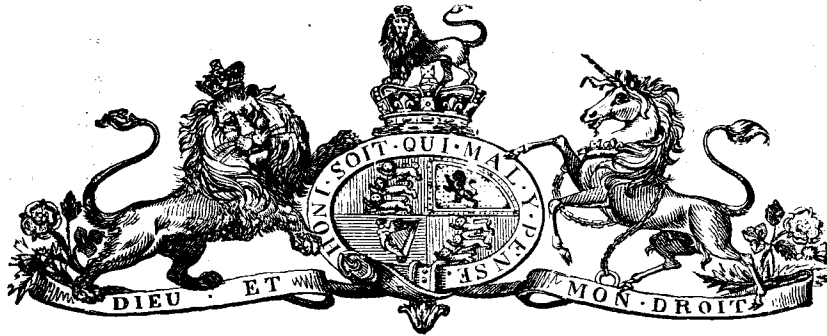

AN ACT to remove Doubts as to the Construction of "The Governor's Salary Act, 1892." [5 December, 1902.]

A.D. 1902.

WHEREAS by "The Governor's Salary Act, 1892," it is enacted that there shall be payable for and in respect of the Salary and Allowances of every Governor of *Tasmania* the sums set forth in the Schedule to the said Act:

PREAMBLE.
56 Vict. No. 11

And it is thereby further enacted that such sums shall, *inter alia*, include all provision for the travelling expenses of the Governor:

And whereas doubts have arisen as to the construction of the words "Travelling Expenses of the Governor," as used in Section Two of the said Act:

And whereas it is expedient to remove such doubts:

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, 4d.]

include railway
fares, &c.

1 The words "The Travelling Expenses of the Governor," as used in "The Governor's Salary Act, 1892," shall not be deemed to include fares for any Governor of *Tasmania*, his family, or any members of his Staff, nor the cost of providing or the hire of any special train for the conveyance of any Governor of *Tasmania* on any railway the property of the State of *Tasmania*.
