AN ACT to remove Doubts as to the Con-A.D. 1902. struction of "The Governor's Salary Act, [5 December, 1902.] 1892."

W HEREAS by "The Governor's Salary Act, 1892," it is enacted PREAMBLE. that there shall be payable for and in respect of the Salary and 56 Vict. No. 11 Allowances of every Governor of Tasmania the sums set forth in the Schedule to the said Act:

And it is thereby further enacted that such sums shall, inter alia, include all provision for the travelling expenses of the Governor:

And whereas doubts have arisen as to the construction of the words "Travelling Expenses of the Governor," as used in Section Two of the said Act:

And whereas it is expedient to remove such doubts:

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, **4***d*.

Governor's Salary.

by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Travelling Expenses of the Governor not to include railway fares, &c.

1 The words "The Travelling Expenses of the Governor," as used in "The Governor's Salary Act, 1892," shall not be deemed to include fares for any Governor of *Tasmania*, his family, or any members of his Staff, nor the cost of providing or the hire of any special train for the conveyance of any Governor of *Tasmania* on any railway the property of the State of *Tasmania*.
