

AN ACT to remove Doubts as to the Meaning

of certain Expressions in The State Aid Distribution Act. [21 December, 1871.]

W HEREAS doubts have arisen as to whether any Minister of PREAMBLE. Religion named in the Schedule to The State Aid Distribution Act may 26 Vict. No. 17. be absent from Tasmania on leave of absence granted to him by the proper be absent from Tasmania on leave of absence granted to him by the proper authority of the Church to which he belongs, unless such leave of absence has been sanctioned by the Governor in Council: And whereas it is expedient to remove such doubts: Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, that the Ninth Section of The State Aid Distribution As to leave of Act shall not be construed to mean that any Minister of Religion may be absent from Tasmania on leave of absence granted to him by the proper authority of the Church to which he belongs, unless such leave of absence has been sanctioned by the Governor in Council.
