

AN ACT to remove doubts as to the opera- A.D. 1899. tion of "The Electoral Act, 1896," and to validate certain Electoral Rolls and Polling Lists. [11 July, 1899.]

W HEREAS "The Electoral Act, 1896," was declared to remain PREAMBLE. and continue in full force and operation until the Thirty-first day of 60 Vict. No. 49. December, One thousand eight hundred and ninety-eight:

And whereas during the last Session of Parliament a Bill was passed by both Houses of Parliament, inter alia, to continue the said Act for a further period, but the Royal Assent to such Bill was not proclaimed in *Tasmania* until the Third day of *February*, One thousand eight hundred and ninety-nine:

And whereas doubts have arisen as to whether "The Electoral Act, 1896," has been in force as from the Thirty-first day of December, One thousand eight hundred and ninety-eight:

And whereas it is desirable that such doubts should be removed, and that certain Electoral Rolls and Polling Lists should be ratified by Parliament:

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:-

1 "The Electoral Act, 1896," shall for all purposes be deemed to 60 Vict. No. 49 be and to have been in force as from the Thirty-first day of December, deemed to have One thousand eight hundred and ninety-eight; and all acts, matters, been in too since 31st

December, 1898.

and things done or purporting to have been done under or in compliance with the provisions of that Act since such last-mentioned date are hereby declared to be valid and effectual.

Electoral Rolls, &c., for certain Council Districts ratified. 2 The Electoral Roll and Polling List for the Electoral Districts of Derwent and Gordon, as prepared by the Returning Officer for the Electoral District of Derwent, and respectively signed by him on the Twentieth and Eighteenth days of May, One thousand eight hundred and ninety-nine, are hereby declared to be the Electoral Roll and Polling List respectively for the Districts of Derwent and Gordon; and the Electors whose names are on such Rolls shall be entitled to vote at any Election of a Member to represent either of such Districts, as the case may be, in the Legislative Council between the date of the passing of this Act and the Eleventh day of April, One thousand nine hundred.

Electoral Rolls for certain Assembly Districts ratified. 3 The Electoral Roll and Polling List for the Electoral Districts of Zeehan and Lyell, as prepared by the Returning Officer for the Electoral District of Zeehan, and signed by him on the Thirteenth day of May, One thousand eight hundred and ninety-nine, are hereby declared to be the Electoral Roll and Polling List respectively for the Districts of Zeehan and Lyell; and the Electors whose names are on such Rolls shall be entitled to vote at any Election of a Member to represent either of such Districts, as the case may be, in the House of Assembly between the date of the passing of this Act and the Eleventh day of April, One thousand nine hundred.
