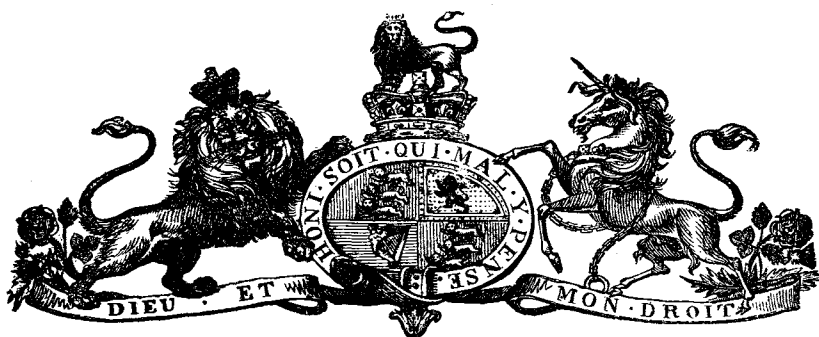

AN ACT to remove Doubts as to the right A.D. 1894.
of certain Persons to claim the benefit of —
The Superannuation Act upon their Retirement
from the Public Service of *Tasmania*.
[25 August, 1894.]

WHEREAS doubts exist as to whether a Superannuation Allowance PREAMBLE.
in accordance with the provisions of *The Superannuation Act* can be 24 Vict. No. 15.
granted to *Edwin Cradock Nowell*, Esquire, and *Frederick Augustus* Vol IV P 2122
Packer, Esquire, upon their retirement from the respective offices
which they now hold in the Public Service of the Colony: And
whereas it is desirable that such doubts should be removed by Legis-
lative enactment:

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*,
by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and
House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 It shall be lawful for the Governor in Council to grant a Super-
annuation Allowance in accordance with the provisions of *The Super-
annuation Act* to *Edwin Cradock Nowell*, Esquire, Clerk of the
Legislative Council and Executive Council, and *Frederick Augustus*
Packer, Esquire, Clerk of the House of Assembly, upon their retirement
from their respective offices in the Public Service of the Colony, subject
