

AN ACT to remove Doubts as to the right A.D. 1894. of certain Persons to claim the benefit of The Superannuation Act upon their Retirement from the Public Service of Tasmania. [25 August, 1894.]

W HEREAS doubts exist as to whether a Superannuation Allowance PREAMBLE. in accordance with the provisions of The Superannuation Act can be 24 Vict. No. 15. granted to Edwin Cradock Nowell, Esquire, and Frederick Augustus Packer, Esquire, upon their retirement from the respective offices which they now hold in the Public Service of the Colony: And whereas it is desirable that such doubts should be removed by Legislative enactment:

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:-

1 It shall be lawful for the Governor in Council to grant a Super- E. C. Nowell, annuation Allowance in accordance with the provisions of The Super-Esquire, and annuation Act to Edwin Cradock Nowell, Esquire, Clerk of the Legislative Council and Executive Council, and Frederick Augustus Esquire, to have benefit of Packer, Esquire, Clerk of the House of Assembly, upon their retirement 24 Vict. No. 15. from their respective offices in the Public Service of the Colony, subject however, to all the provisions of the said Act.
