AN ACT to repeal portion of an Act for the A.D. 1889. Erection of an Invalid Depôt, and for the Sale of a certain piece of Land in the City of Launceston. [26 September, 1889.]

WHEREAS it is expedient that the Act of Parliament of Tasmania PREAMBLE. of the 45th Victoria, No. 26, so far as the same relates to the sale of 45 Vict. No. 26. a certain piece of land described in the Schedule to the said Act, should be repealed:

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 The Fourth and Fifth Sections of the Act of Parliament of Sections 4 and Tasmania of the 45th Victoria, No. 26, together with the Schedule to of 45 Vict. No. 26, repealed. the said Act, are hereby repealed.
