AN ACT to restore the Jurisdiction of the Court
of Requests holden in and for the District of
Hobart Town. [7th January, 1857.]

WHEREAS by Section 205 of "*The Common Law Procedure Act*" it was enacted that the Jurisdiction of any Court of Requests holden in and for the District of *Hobart Town* should be limited to Actions to an Amount not exceeding Ten Pounds—And whereas it is expedient to restore the Jurisdiction of the said Court in Actions to an Amount not exceeding Thirty Pounds—Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the Advice and Consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :

Section 205 of "*The Common Law Procedure Act*" is hereby repealed, and so much of the Act of Council of this Island of the Sixth Victoria, No. 9, and of the Act of Council of this Island of the Sixteenth Victoria, No. 10, as is repealed or in anywise affected by the said Section of "*The Common Law Procedure Act*," is hereby revived and continued.
